Key Takeaways to Remember

Survey results are inconclusive.

As part of this process, G-PISD communicated that "the district will continue with current procedures at, or until, at least 65% of our families respond to this survey." A total of 1,278 submissions were received, which is 16% of total family contacts via email.

Given this information, there will be no changes to current procedures regarding lunch visits for the remainder of the school year 2022-23. As a reminder, families can check out a child for a lunch break if desired under current procedures.

Next Steps for 2023-2024

G-PISD annually reviews safety and security procedures in the summer prior to the upcoming school year. Given no conclusive results from this survey, and with awareness that our families who have expressed their opinions are divided as it pertains to this topic, it has been scheduled as the first agenda item for the district's new **Family Engagement Committee**.

This committee will be formed to expand the voices of our families -- providing another layer of input in addition to all other committees. Participants will weigh in with their feedback on key matters including safety, future calendar options, family requests/needs, volunteerism, and more. G-PISD will provide more information and an opportunity for those interested to volunteer this May with meetings beginning in June 2023.
