Virtual (Online) Academy

- All instruction, work completed each day at home using district-issued device(s) with direction, support from teachers
- Daily attendance recorded as required based on engagement/contact with teacher(s) and assignment completion
- Flexibility during the school day to meet family needs, as long as student keeps up with daily assignments/schedule and communicates with teacher(s) every day



Daily, Face-to-Face In-School Instruction

- Students on campus for the entire school day, with teachers providing face-to-face instruction each day.
- Safety protocols and social distancing in place to the best possible degree, aligned with governor/state orders and guidelines.
- Frequent sanitizing/disinfecting on campus.
- Scheduling designed to limit prolonged contact with a large number of different students throughout the day, as reasonable/able.
