

Gregory-Portland Independent School District High School Summer Academy 2009

The Secondary Summer Academy is designed to provide additional instructional opportunities for High School students. High School students should consider attending the Summer Academy if they need to recover credit for a course that they did not pass or if they want to earn credit towards graduation that will provide the student flexibility in taking additional electives during the fall or spring semesters.

Space in the Summer Academy is **limited**. Students who qualify will be accepted on a first-come, first served basis.

Grades 9 – 12 Credit Recovery or Acceleration

- Student may choose to take courses for credit recovery or acceleration.
 - Acceleration courses offered will include:
 - For Seniors and Early Graduates – Government and Economics
 - For incoming Grade 9 and above – Health
 - For incoming Grade 9 and above – Speech
- High School Courses will cost \$75 each. This fee is not refundable. Scholarships for fees may be available. See counselor for additional information.

The Secondary Summer Academy will be located at Gregory-Portland High School.
