

Major Changes in Student Dress Code Approved for 2009-10

No changes were made for student dress in **grades PK-4**.

Major changes for students in **grades 5-12** include:

1. Allowing students to wear only two types of acceptable shirts:
 - Polo-style shirts, solid colors only; no logos; no lettering; and
 - GPISD school spirit and GPISD organization shirts (pre-approved by campus administration).
2. Restricting shirts and hoodies from having a logo of any kind or size;
3. Lowering the length of shorts, skirts, and skorts to the top of the kneecap (previously the length could be no shorter than 3 inches above the top of the kneecap);
4. lowering dress length to the top of the kneecap in grades 5-6; and
5. Moving “hoodies” to be grouped with “Sweatshirts, Pullover and Cardigan-Style Sweaters, Vests, and “Hoodies” and removing them from the category of outerwear. In grades 7-12, approved “hoodies” are similar to approved shirts.
