The Gregory-Portland ISD Athletic Department is providing online ticketing to purchase tickets for all of the G-PISD 2020-2021 Athletic Events.

<u>UIL Guidelines Due to Covid-19</u> (Spectators, Audiences, Fans and Media)

Schools may allow spectators to attend games, contests, or events within a maximum 50% capacity limitation, provided that appropriate spacing between spectators is maintained according to the protocol and according to the following:

- Schools and/or host sites should post visible signs and/or messaging stating any individuals who
 are confirmed to have, suspected of having, are experiencing symptoms of, or have been in close
 contact with an individual who has been confirmed to have COVID-19 should not enter the
 facility.
- All employees, parents, visitors, and students ten years of age or older must wear face coverings
 or face shields upon entry to an area where UIL activities are being conducted and when not
 actively practicing or playing in the contest.

Exceptions: Any person with a medical condition or disability that prevents wearing a face covering or while a person is consuming food or drink. Must be prepared to show proof of condition/disability.

Sites are encouraged to utilize remote ticketing options to help manage capacity limitations within a maximum 50% occupancy. Paper tickets and programming should be minimized to help avoid transferable materials. Full UIL Covid-19 Guidelines https://www.uiltexas.org/policy/covid-19.

Information for Previous Reserved Season Ticket Holders:

- All seats will be General Admission with no Reserved Seating due to COVID-19. All spectators must follow Social Distancing Guidelines.

G-PISD Ticket & Entry Procedures

NO TICKETS WILL BE SOLD AT THE GATE FOR ANY HOME EVENT!

- All tickets for home events must be purchased on the G-P High School Website under the Athletics tab (shortcut link: www.g-pisd.org/athletics)
- All tickets for away events must be purchased on the Host School's Website as Visitor Tickets or at the gate depending on their ticketing system.
- At the gate, you will need to provide a digital ticket or printed ticket to be scanned.
- Screening will be performed at the gate. If you are running a temperature greater than or equal to 100.4 degrees or if you have any Covid-19 symptoms, you will not be allowed to enter.
- All spectators must follow Social Distancing Guidelines.
- Face coverings will be required.

General Admission Tickets for 2020/2021

FOOTBALL – HS Varsity/Junior Varsity/Freshman & Middle School (MS)

HOME SIDE - General Admission Tickets must be purchased on a weekly basis.

General Admission Tickets will be available for parents of participants to purchase at least 48 hours before the game starting at 12pm on our Athletic website. Each participant will be allowed three (3) tickets. The tickets must be purchased at the same time and you must sit together in the designated areas in the stadium.

Tickets will open to the general public the day of the event at 12pm.

Click on the "Red Ticket" and it will take you to events. Make sure you click on the correct event (Home-Varsity Football, Home-Junior Varsity & Freshmen). Parents will need to enter their child's student ID as a "passcode" to be able to open the purchase ticket screen.

VISITOR'S SIDE - General Admission Tickets will be available for parents to purchase at least 48 hours before the game starting at 12pm on our Athletic website. Each participant will be allowed 2 tickets. The tickets must be purchased at the same time and you must sit together in the designated areas in the stadium.

Tickets will open to the general public the day of the event at 12pm - Spectators will be allowed to purchase tickets on the day of event starting at 12pm-7:30pm

Home Capacity = 681 / Visitors Capacity = 381

VOLLEYBALL – High School

General Admission Tickets will be available for parents to purchase at least 24 hours before the game starting at 12pm on our Athletic website. Each participant will be allowed <u>two (2) tickets</u>. The tickets must be purchased at the same time and you must sit together in the designated areas in the gym. Tickets will open to the general public the day of the event at 12pm.

VOLLEYBALL – Middle School

Ticket Pricing

All Junior-Varsity Football & Volleyball Tickets will be \$3.00 plus a \$1.00 HTT Charge and CC Transaction Fee.

All Varsity Football Tickets will be \$5.00 plus a \$1.00 HTT charge, and CCT Transaction Fee.

No Passes will be allowed at the gate, with the exception of Media Passes (must stand on the sidelines and get screened prior to entering the Stadium). Please contact the Athletic Office for a Media Pass. All spectators will need a ticket.
