

Nurse's Corner—Sonia Marquez, R.N.

For the health and wellness of our students and staff: Please remember that the School District has a policy (following recommendations from Texas State Health Services) that addresses conditions for which a student be excluded from the classroom. Along with communicable diseases, this policy requires that schools **exclude students who are vomiting, have diarrhea, or fever over 100 degrees.** It also requires that they be excluded from the classroom for 24 hours after the <u>LAST</u> incident of vomiting/diarrhea/fever. The "fever free" portion of the rule specifies that the student must be fever free (**without** the use of fever reducing medications like Tylenol/Motrin) for 24 hours prior to returning to school. The exception to this readmission policy is that with a note from the MD or Nurse Practitioner which states the student's condition is not contagious, the student may be re-admitted prior to School Nurses the 24 hours.
