



Library Book Checkout Procedures During Covid

1) Log In to Destiny

Students should log into their Destiny library software accounts which they can access through **Clever.com** or by going to https://gpisd.follettdestiny.com/common/welcome.jsp?context=saas42_4239707_Students log into Destiny using the same username and password they use to log onto a school computer. For example - John Doe (ID # 242424) would be jdoe24@student.g-pisd.org and his password would be gp242424.

2) Put a book on hold

After searching for a title or doing a keyword search, click the **name of the title** on the search results screen. On the next screen, click the "Hold It" button on the upper right corner.

3) Wait for delivery

Library staff will be alerted automatically when a book has been put on hold. We will deliver the book to the student's room as promptly as possible. We will quarantine the books for a week upon their return.

Checking Student Library Records

Students may check their own library accounts to see what they have checked out and any fines that they have. There are two ways to do this:

- From the main screen, they can go to "My Info" in the upper left corner beside the "catalog" tab, or
- From the main screen, they can click on the "Destiny Discover" tab on the left-hand side menu, then click on their name or the person icon and select checkouts, holds, fines, etc.

Note: In Destiny Discover, if they click the back-browser button, it will completely kick them out of Destiny and they'll have to re-login.

8. Who is one of your heroes, and why?



8. Who is one of your heroes, and why?


My dad is my hero because, no matter what life has thrown his way, he has always remained resilient and solid. He truly is the best dad in the world.
