## World Geography

### Summer Packet 2020

I am very excited to have you as a part of my Advanced World Geography Class. This year we will be exploring all 7 continents. For each continent there will be 3 different topics to study and learn. We will be looking at: Geography, History, and Culture. The summer packet is provided to help us get a head start on our work during the next school year. **This is very important.** The entire packet is due the first Friday of the new Fall semester. Please make sure that it is complete before then. This packet is made up of 3 sections: vocabulary, the world map, and the U.S. map.

**Part 1:** You have 14 vocabulary words to learn. You will look up each word. You will write the definition, use the word in a sentence, and then provide an illustration for the word. The illustration **MUST** fit in the box provided. Handwriting **MUST** be legible to receive credit. There are 14 vocabulary words, there need to be **14 DIFFERENT** sentences.

**Part 2:** You will label the world map that is provided. There is a list of the 7 continents, 10 countries, and 5 oceans provided that you will label. Handwriting **MUST** be legible to receive credit. Make sure that it is easy to understand which label belongs to which item.

**Part 3:** You will label the United States map. You will write the name of each of the 50 states within the actual state on the map. Handwriting **MUST** be legible to receive credit. Make sure that it is easy to understand which label belongs to which item.
